There is also a wood heater and air conditioner to keep you comfortable all year round. Water is no problem with 3 rainwater tanks and the ability to take water from the river for stock and domestic use. A new shower, toilet and laundry is in the house while there is also a shower and toilet block for your guests that may choose to camp, van, or bunk in the old shack also on the property. Two carports and some shedding will accommodate your vehicles and provide storage. There is a cleared area around the house and shed while you can walk/or drive up the hill into the bush to take in the views from this 3.75 acre property. Chill out at the property or explore the area including the Tambo River, Tambo Valley Golf Course, Swifts Creek township, pub, general store, bakery, park and outdoor pool. Venture further to Omeo, Hotham Snow Fields, Ensay and check out the wineries and eateries, fishing spots, 4 wheel drive tracks and much more. And if you really need to check your emails & socials or stream a movie at night, satellite internet is available. Note: Google Maps and Satnav will likely take you to a water crossing where you need a 4WD. Ignore those final directions (DO NOT take Nunniong Road) Stay on the Bindi Road until you cross the Tambo River then turn right onto the Old Bindi Road. Please ask for our mud map.
