You will not want for anything on the over 5.19 acre hobby farm. The current owners built their modern four-bedroom home in 2020 so you have the comfort of the remaining years of the builder's warranty. It has a practical floor plan with two living zones with the kitchen and family area facing north to take advantage of winter sun. This area has a split system air conditioner, sold fuel heater and ceiling fan. Step outside and enjoy the mountain views from the large alfresco area or watch the cows or horses graze in the two paddocks below. The main bedroom has a walk-in robe and ensuite and is separately zoned from the remaining three bedrooms, all with BIR's. Tank and town water is connected so there is plenty of water for the entire family, stock and plants. Extensive landscaping has been undertaken including retaining walls to make full use of the land and provide definition between areas. Apart from the double garage under roofline, there is a stone driveway leading to an 8m x 16m Colorbond shed with two open bays and a lock up area of 8m x 8m.
